We are looking for a mature, enthusiastic and engaging individual who will share their passion for swimming and be responsible for the swim program. Together with all Club Coaches and the Vice President of Coaching, this individual will also support the growth of the Club and help foster strong relationships with City staff, local community and within all British Columbia Summer Swimming Association clubs.

General Job Description:

- Supervises and mentors all swim coaches.
- Directs coaches in establishing goals and tools for the successful development of all swimmers.
- Develops and implements a seasonal swim training program and monthly practice schedules for the whole Club.
- Manages and conducts swim team workouts and technical swim training for assigned group(s).
- Manages, observes and evaluates assigned swimmers at practices and swim meets.
- Supports all swim coaches to manage, observe and evaluate their assigned swimmers at practices and swim meets.
- Uses a digital platform to track assigned group progression and provides continual feedback to swimmers and communication to parents.
- Delegates tasks and swim groups to swim coaches.
- Provides educational opportunities to swim coaches and volunteers where possible.
- Collaborates with all coaching staff to identify best practices in supporting all members.
- Attends and participates at board meetings.
- Performs various clerical duties such as maintaining attendance on a digital platform.
- Oversees the overall safety of swimmers during training and at swim meets.
- Supervises the use, safety, and storage of Sunfish equipment.
- Develops and educates self to become a more effective coach, which will include staying up-to-date with coaching certification, accepting mentorship where possible and participating in clinics and workshops.
- Attends swim competitions (swim meets, Regionals and Provincials).
- Manages swimmer information on Hytek and Active.
- Lifeguards when needed.
- Participates in Club activities (ie social activities, fundraisers, etc.).
- Acts in accordance with the BCSSA Coaches Code of Ethics.
- Performs other related duties as assigned by the Board.
