We are looking for enthusiastic, positive, energetic and committed individuals who are passionate about swimming and coaching.

General Job Description:

- Reports to the Swim Head Coach.
- Collaborates with other Senior Coaches.
- Supervises and mentors Junior Coaches.
- Designs and implements practice plans.
- Meets with swimmers and/or parents to discuss group goals and progress.
- Instructs and tracks progression of assigned groups of swimmers using digital platforms.
- Recommends movement of swimmers to appropriate swim groups.
- Forwards parent concerns to the Swim Head Coach.
- Mentors volunteer coaches.
- Assists in the supervision of the overall safety of swimmers during training and at swim meets.
- Assists in the supervision of the use, safety, and storage of Sunfish equipment.
- Develops and educates self to become a more effective coach, which will include staying up-to-date with coaching certification, accepting mentorship where possible and participating in clinics and workshops that may be available.
- Attends swim competitions (swim meets, Regionals and Provincials) and tracks swimmer performance times on Hytek and Active.
- Lifeguards when needed.
- Attends weekly coach meetings and reviews weekly training plans with coaching staff.
- Determines own Group's year-end awards and presents at Awards Night.
- Participates in Club activities (ie social activities, fundraisers, etc.).
- Acts in accordance with the BCSSA Coaches Code of Ethics.
- Performs other related duties as assigned by the Board.
