

# **North Delta Sunfish Swim Club**

## **Amendment to all Safety Plans (indoor / outdoor) - September 8, 2021**

In our current Step 3 Amendment Plan, the following were approved:

- Increased capacity of swimmers allowed. No cohort limitations
- Volunteer coaches are allowed to be in the water with the swimmers thus allowing us to open registration to “Little Fishies” groups.
- Coaches can now stop wearing masks on deck at the outdoor pool while coaching - unless they are within 2 metres of swimmers.

We are now updating our Step 3 Amendment to note reminders and changes. **PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING:**

### **Sports**

*Adult and youth outdoor and indoor group and team sports*

*All outdoor and indoor group sports for adults and youth are allowed. This includes:*

- *Games*
- *Competitions*
- *Practices*

### **Spectators**

*Outdoor sport activities can have 5,000 spectators or 50% seated capacity, whichever is greater. For example, if the venue has a normal seated capacity of 30,000 people, 15,000 spectators can attend.*

*Indoor sport activities can have 50 spectators or 50% seated capacity, whichever is greater. For example, if the venue has a normal seated capacity of 500 people, 250 spectators can attend.*

### **Mask Mandate for Indoor Facilities**

*Effective August 25, 2020, the Provincial Health Mask Mandate requires the use of a mask inside Delta Recreation Facilities.*

*Please wear a mask upon entry to the facilities. Masks can be removed once in the changerooms and you are going to take your cleansing shower or if you are on the deck for dryland and finished dryland training and about to get into the water. Upon completion of your swimming sessions. Swimmer will need to wear masks when exiting the facility. This will be on deck at Sungod and in the changerooms at Winskill and Ladner. Coaches and spectators alike will also be required to wear masks at all times while in the facilities. Coaches are exempt from wearing masks while on the field of play. Currently **Field of Play** is coaching swimmers/players during their swim practice time while swimmers are in the water. Signage will be posted in and around facilities to assist you.*

**NOTE:** Any further update to our safety plans will be issued under an Amendment, unless a redesign of a plan is warranted.
